If you have questions regarding this appointment please call **937-257-8600**. If your insurance requires pre-certification, please give our office a call and we will assist you.

From North of I-70 (Tipp City – Troy – Vandalia): I-70 E (Exit 61A toward Columbus) to OH-4 S (Exit 41) toward Fairborn. Exit Chambersburg Rd./OH-235 S Ramp. Turn Left on OH- 235 and follow to OH-444/N. Broad St. Turn Right onto OH-444/N. Broad St. and follow OH-444 S to Gate 9A. Turn Right into the gate. See Below.

From the East on 70 (Springfield – Columbus): I-70 W to I-675 S (Exit 44). Follow I-675 to SR 444 (Exit 24). Follow SR 444/Broad St. through Fairborn to Wright-Patterson AFB Gate 9A. Turn Right into the gate. See Below.

From Huber Heights: Take Chambersburg Rd./235 to Fairborn. Turn Right on Broad St./SR 444. Follow SR 444 to Gate 9A. Turn Right into the gate. See Below.

From the South on I-675 North: I-675 N. Exit Fairfield Rd./844 N Exit #17. Stay to your left onto 844 N. exit 3 onto SR 444/Fairborn. Turn Left onto OH-444 follow to Gate 9A. Turn Left into the gate. See Below.

From the South (West Carrollton – Downtown Dayton): I-75 N to OH-SR 4 N. (Exit 54C). OH-4 N. exit to 444 N. (Area A & C). Continue to follow OH-444 until Gate 9A. Turn Left into the gate. See Below.



Please inform the gate guard that you have an appointment at the **Wound Healing and Hyperbaric Medicine Center**. **You will be required to show a photo ID.**

Entering through Gate 9A: Immediately turn Left onto Sugar Maple Dr.

Turn into the Main Hospital Entrance. On your Right you will see parking spaces reserved for Hyperbaric Patients. You are now directly in front of our center. Additional reserved parking can be found across the street in the first row.
